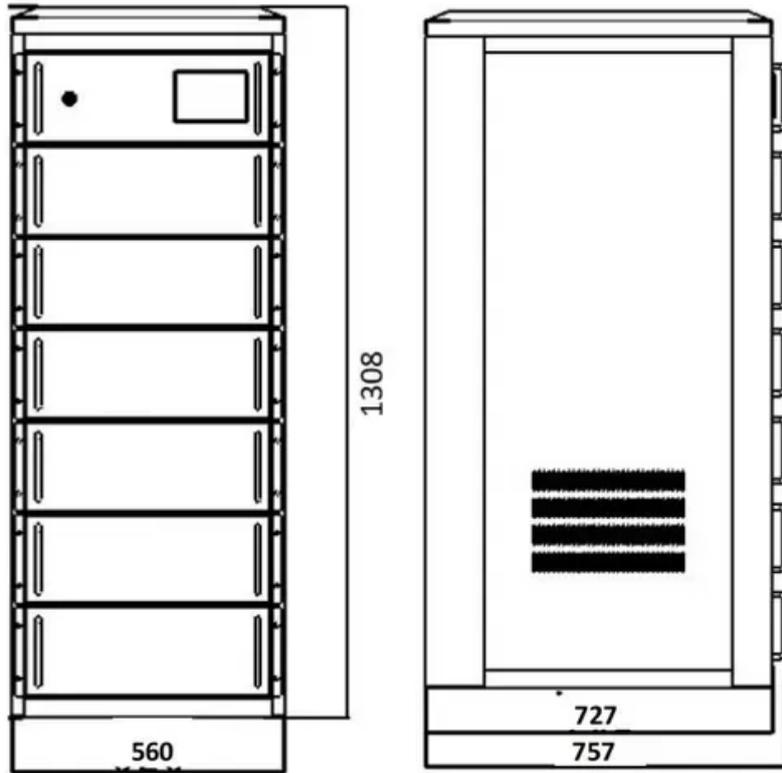


Ashgabat energy independence



Overview

Turkmenistan is trying to shed its long-standing image as a hermit kingdom, at least when it comes to natural gas exports. Over the past few months, Ashgabat has gone on a deal-making binge that, over the long term, could significantly alter the European Union's energy-import. Since declaring independence in 1991, it has built its foreign policy around “permanent neutrality,” a status formally recognized by the United Nations in 1995. Neutrality has meant avoiding military alliances, steering clear of regional blocs, and limiting international engagement to carefully. Turkmenistan's capital is making waves with its Ashgabat Energy Storage Power Station policy, a strategic move to modernize its energy infrastructure. 2 billion project aims to store surplus solar energy during peak production hours for nighttime use - addressing the. On September 22, a scientific-practical conference titled “Independence - the source of development and transformations” was held at the State Energy Institute of Turkmenistan. The event was dedicated to the 34th anniversary of Turkmenistan's Independence. With 68% of Turkmenistan's electricity still coming from coal plants (per 2023 National Energy Report), the capital's air quality index hit 156 last month - that's three times WHO's safety threshold.
