

# Australia solar power maseru



## Overview

The SRES is an Australian Government program based around tradable certificates called small-scale technology certificates (STCs). Eligible installations of rooftop solar are entitled to STCs, creating a subsidy for households and businesses that install these renewable energy. The 70 MW solar power station project is under construction in the Maseru district. It is the first utility-scale solar project in Lesotho, divided into two phases: the first phase will deliver 30 MW and the second 40 MW, with commissioning scheduled for early 2025. The consortium is led by Scatec. This summary covers an application for MIGA political risk insurance by the Renewable Energy Performance Platform of the United Kingdom (REPP; the Guarantee Holder) for its non-shareholder loan into Neo 1 SPV PTY Limited of Lesotho (Neo1; the Project Enterprise) to develop a 20 MW solar PV power. Maseru, the capital city of Lesotho, presents a generally favorable location for solar PV energy generation. Situated in the Southern Sub Tropics at coordinates -29.4814, this location experiences varying levels of solar potential throughout the year. The Power Purchase Agreement, Connection Agreement and Implementation Agreement were signed at an official ceremony held in Lesotho's capital. 
