

# Belize device to 220 inverter



## Overview

---

For devices that operate solely on 220-240V voltage, you will need a power converter to safely use them in Belize-failure to do so could risk your devices and compromise your ability to capture those stunning sunsets over the Caribbean or the intricate details of ancient Mayan ruins. Which power outlets do they use in Belize?

The voltage range for Belize is 110/220V, while the standard frequency is 60Hz. Belize is unusual in that it has multiple voltage types depending on the region or city. The power supply is inconsistent throughout the country and some locations run power at. Before you travel, check the information below to make sure your electronic devices are compatible with the outlet type and voltage. You will need an adapter for type A and G power outlets in Belize.

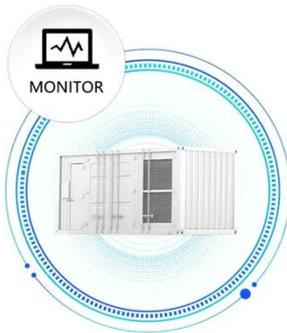

In Belize's 220 V regions you will need a voltage converter, since your USA's device will typically support 120 V. In regions where 110 is used, a converter is not necessary.


