

Can firewood be placed under photovoltaic panels



Overview

Firewood stays dry and well-aerated under solar panels. Stack it off the ground on pallets to prevent rot, and you've got a perfect, out-of-the-way storage area that doesn't take up extra yard space. Here are five smart ways to utilize the area underneath. Reason I'm going flat is because the only way to get them in the sun is to put them about 8 feet high to clear fence and other obstructions so it's only really viable to put them flat at that height or it would be an eye sore. But then it got me wondering if I'm basically creating a huge fire. I'm planning to use MCA-treated wood, which supposedly less toxic to metals (and people), particularly the aluminum in the panel frames; also, around here at least, it's easier to. 1a) Mount the post on say, 8 ft centers, tie them together with 2x6s horizontally (3 rows per side), and mount two sets of panels on each (with the fronts reversed so that one string is optimized for morning sun, the other for afternoon).
