



Overview

It is not recommended to use tap water to wash panels – it is often hard and may contribute to the formation of scale deposits, which will reduce the photopermeability of our batteries. Use non-abrasive sponges, microfiber cloths, or soft. To clean solar panels, start by turning off the system for safety. Then, remove any loose debris with a brush or leaf blower. Many cleaning products leave a residue that can sometimes affect efficiency. Aggressive detergents should also be avoided. If water is not enough to remove dirt, you.

How to Clean Solar Panels Safely & Efficiently

In general, a mixture of water and mild detergent (like dish soap) works well, though you can also use 1 part vinegar and 8 parts water or a solar panel cleaning solution.

The panels should be washed with pure water, which is applied evenly across the surface to help loosen the dirt. If there is concern about mineral content in the water, low-mineral water can be used.
