

Grid modernization oman



Overview

Oman Electricity Transmission Company (OETC), the majority state-owned operator and owner of the country's national grid, has unveiled plans for substantial investments in a broad portfolio of network expansion and modernization projects aimed at supporting Oman's ambitious clean energy vision. Announced in October, 2020, the government's Rabt programme is designed to support economic growth and national energy security through the modernisation of Oman's power system, integrating the north and south sections of the grid and upgrading its capabilities. In addition to sustainable energy, Oman is fast-tracking renewable power projects and grid upgrades while targeting 8.5m tonnes of hydrogen production by 2050, as it seeks to transform its utilities sector under Vision 2040. Recent reports highlight substantial progress in expanding and upgrading the national electricity. Oman Electricity Transmission Company (OETC) has allocated \$2.5 billion for these investments.
