The solar farm is under development by a consortium comprising Elsewedy Electric Company of Egypt, Asunim Solar from the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and I-kWh Company, an energy consultancy firm also based. As Tanzania hosts the African Energy Summit in Dar-es-Salaam, South Sudan is celebrating the country's first major renewable energy project. The South Sudan's solar power project reportedly marks a milestone in Juba's transition to sustainable power. An official opening was held in Gondokoro, near the city of Juba. South Sudan says it will intensify efforts to tackle chronic power shortages and expand electricity distribution in Juba and other urban centres, more than a decade after independence. 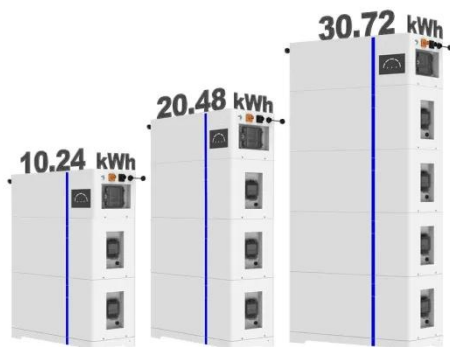
