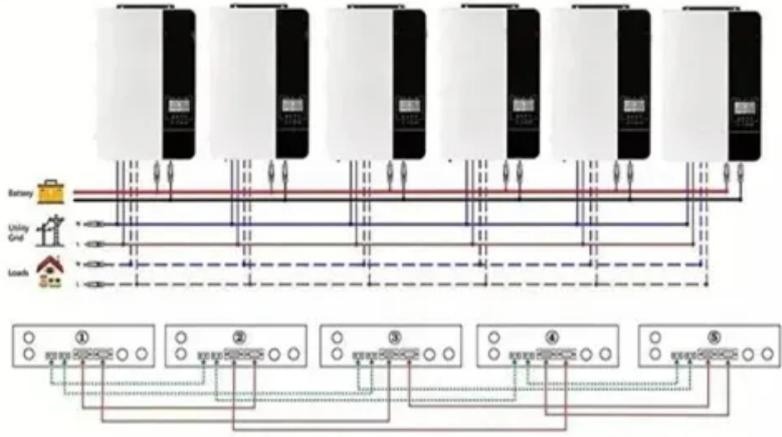




Overview

Mogadishu – Somalia has unveiled ambitious energy targets under its National Transformation Plan (NTP), pledging to expand electricity coverage from the current 69. This study examines the non-technical and structural barriers that constrain access to affordable and reliable electricity in Somalia, focusing on Mogadishu's private energy market, which is dominated by the Banadir Electricity Company (BECO), Blue Sky Energy, and Mogadishu Power Supply (MPS). Addressing these challenges is essential for ensuring safety, fostering. There are significant differences in electricity access between places of residence, as most urban dwellers have access to electricity (80.1 percent) while only about a third of rural residents (39.9 percent) and fewer than 9 percent of nomads or migratory herders have access to reliable. Mogadishu 13, July, 2023, the Cabinet of the Federal Government of Somalia has taken an unprecedented move to transform the energy sector and officially approved and endorsed the establishment of the National Electricity Authority (NEA).
