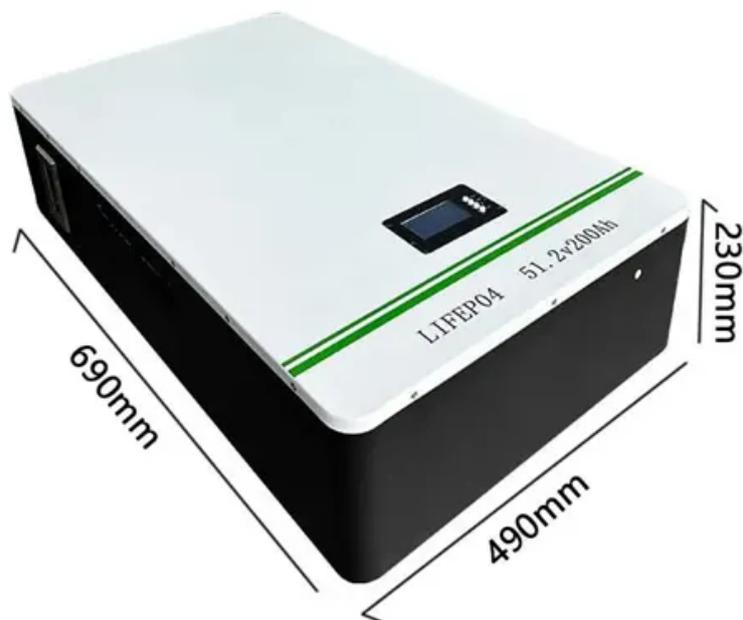


Nigeria energy storage power station dispatch subsidies



Overview

According to Bloomberg Nigerians will get a subsidized 50 kilowatt hours per month, either through consumption or via vouchers, the West African nation said in a pitch to investors at a World Bank energy summit in Tanzania. The African Development Bank on Wednesday said it has committed \$1. 2m in grants to support a feasibility study on Battery Energy Storage Systems in Nigeria. It said the project will assess grid integration, identify viable business and regulatory models to attract investment, and build the capacity. Uptake of biomass (6 GW) and hydrogen (36 GW) in replacement of gas (11. 8 GW) by 2060, due to zero emission constraints in 2060 and need of dispatchable power.
