

Oceania Telecommunications Base Station Electricity Fee Standards



Overview

The decision on who approves a base station depends on several planning factors, including: the classification/zoning of the land. Such facilities are called “network units”. 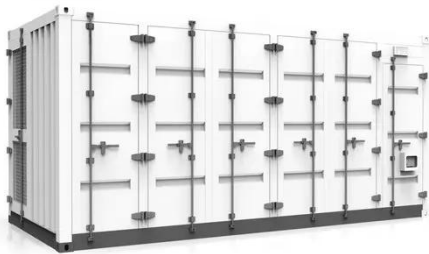
