The European average (including EU, EFTA, and candidate countries) was €28. Household electricity prices increased in 12, decreased in 13 and remained almost unchanged in 2 EU countries, in the first half of 2025, compared with the first half of 2024. 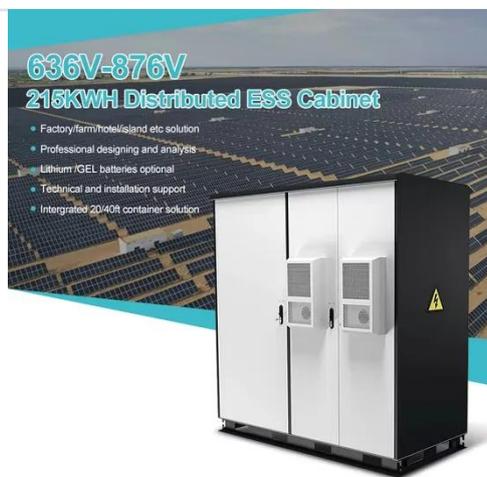

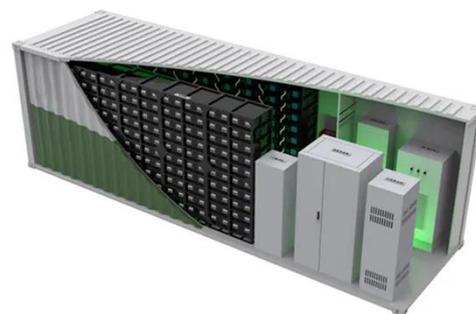
