

Reduced carbon emissions mauritius



Overview

GIS – 21 August 2025: Mauritius is currently formulating its third-generation Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC 3.0) under the Paris Agreement, with updated emission reduction targets and adaptation measures, aiming to make the country more climate-resilient and low-carbon. The island nation's emissions rate stands at 6.2 tonnes of CO₂ per person as of 2023, placing it 48th globally. This interactive chart shows the breakdown of annual CO₂ emissions by source: either coal, oil, gas, cement production or gas flaring. This breakdown is strongly influenced by the energy mix of a given country, and changes as a country shifts to or from a given energy source. How are Mauritius' CO₂ emissions influenced by its basic resources such as land, water and energy supply. In this regard, the EU-funded Switch Africa Green “Sustainable Island Mauritius” (SIM) project aims to facilitate Mauritius' transitioning to an eco-friendly tourism sector in line with its “Maurice Ile Durable” (Mauritius Sustainable Island). Recalling the principle of flexibility inscribed in the Paris Agreement and granted to Mauritius as member of the group of Small Island and Developing States (SIDS), all actions and interventions included in this action plan are indicative and may be subject to further review in the period 2022 –.
