The country registered a total of 22,506 new passenger cars in 2025 across all powertrains. Within Latvia, Riga statistical region (from 01., Ventspils municipality (57) Quadricycles, Mopeds, Lorries (including road tractors), Buses., Motorcycles (6) Number, Share % (2) . 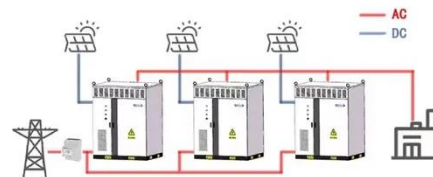
