Although incentives are still developing, several actions are underway: While there is currently no feed-in tariff, net billing schemes are being evaluated, and local awareness of solar benefits is increasing. Several fiscal incentives to promote RE and EE were included in the Finance Act No. 13 of 2010 and came into effect on Janu. Incentives for RE are as follows: a) Import Duty Exemptions are granted for “machinery, equipment materials and parts for the manufacture or assembly of solar water. 

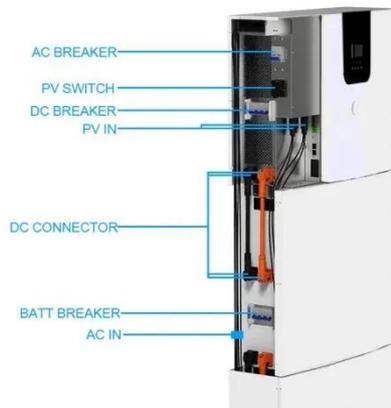
